



EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- FY18 year-end performance totals show increased activity compared to year-end FY17 and in some cases exceeding activity in FY16, before the closure of Martin Luther King Jr. Memorial Library in the Winter of 2017.
 - Circulation (both physical and digital) and wifi access totals have increased to their highest level.
 - FY18 gate count, outreach attendance, library accounts, database usage, computer sessions, adult desktop computer utilization, and meeting and study room use are all up compared to FY17.
 - With 997,120 visitors, Q4 had the highest number of visitors compared to quarters 1,2, and 3. In addition, with 351,272 visitors, the month of August 2018 had the highest number of visitors since August 2016.
- This quarter's report reflects a full quarter of activity for the Cleveland Park neighborhood library since it reopened in mid-June, 2018. This quarter Cleveland Park circulated 99,215 physical items surpassing all other branches. Juvenile books were the most widely circulated at this branch.
- We believe gate count equipment is under-counting the number of visitors at Cleveland Park based on the very high levels of circulation, wifi access, and meeting and study room use compared to activity prior to construction. We are completing an internal review on gate count equipment at Cleveland Park and several other libraries.
- Q4 library programs with highest attendees included the Soul Tent event held at Benning on July 31st with 850 attendees, the 6th Annual Bellevue Back to School Bash held at Bellevue on August 8th with 2,000 attendees, the STAR Festival held at Deanwood on September 8th with 700 attendees, OCTO DC Connect held at Benning on September 29th with 458 attendees, and Art All Night at Tenley Friendship on September 29th with 1,111 attendees.
- DC Public Library facilitated 340 Summer Meals programs for a total of 4,823 persons. Branches with the highest attendance included Benning, Anacostia, and Bellevue with 1,066, 812, and 715 individuals respectively.









ACTIVE ACCOUNTS BY ZIP CODE





Student Accounts as a Percentage of Total



Q4 FY18 Student Computer Sessions




Q4 FY18 Student Circulation



Student Accounts by Zip Code r.







DCPL PERFORMANCE REPORT DATA GLOSSARY

Active Accounts by Ward and Zip Code – The number of user accounts with activity in the last three years. Accounts are sorted by ward and zip code of residence provided in account information. The total is collected on the last day of the reported quarter.

Adult Desktop Computer Utilization – The utilization rate for each library location is the average number of hours of use of adult desktop computers divided by the number of open hours at each location for the quarter.

Books from Birth – Books from Birth is a program for children from birth up to age five to receive a free book each month mailed to their home; families and children are able to keep the books to start a personal library.

Books from Birth – Graduated Citywide – Number of Books from Birth enrollees that have turned five years old and, therefore, aged out the program.

Books from Birth Target Enrollment Areas – Target enrollment areas for Books from Birth include zip codes in Wards 1, 5, 7 and 8.

Circulation – Physical and digital lending transactions from the library's collection; includes outside and in–house use, and renewal circulation transactions.

Customer Access to Wi–Fi – The number of internet connections to the DCPL Wi–Fi network by laptops, smartphones, and other mobile devices.

Database Usage – Counts the number of times users interact with each database. The same counting metric cannot be used for each database. "Database Usage" captures only one metric for each database and can include one of the following: downloads, views, clicks on links, searches, or sessions.

Digital Library and Circulation – Total of all E–Books downloaded and streamed, videos streamed, songs downloaded and streamed, audiobooks downloaded and streamed, and magazines downloaded and streamed. Digital circulation is attributed to library branches based on the library home location on the cardholder's account.

Extended Leave – Categories of legally authorized extended absences other than annual or sick leave that may impact staffing levels and productivity including: Family Medical Leave, Paid Family Leave, American Disability Act and Workers' Compensation.

Gate Count – Number of people entering library locations. Thermal imaging technology senses traffic travelling underneath the sensor. Devices are mounted at public entry and exit locations.

Meeting Room Use and Attendance – The number of times library meeting rooms are used by the public and the number of people attending these meetings.

New Website Visits (Sessions) – Number of first time visits to the website; includes first time users as well as returning users using a different method to access the website.

Outreach – Programs that are planned, sponsored or carried out by the library staff but do not take place at the library.

Overall Website Visits (Sessions) – Number of times the website was visited.

Programs – Programs that take place on DCPL property, including programs that are led by staff members, partner organizations, and paid presenters/contractors. Public programs held in meeting rooms are counted under meeting room use.

Social Media Engagement Rate – Measure of the effectiveness of posts.

Social Media Engagements – The number of people who have engaged (clicked, liked, re-tweeted, etc.) with posts.

Social Media Impressions – The number of times posts have been seen.

Story Time Programs – Story time attendance is the count of the audience (children and adults) at formal story time programs intended for children birth to five years of age and their caregivers. This does not include other, non–story time programming for this age group (for example, baby movement or music programs).

Student Cardholders – Library accounts of registrants aged 19 and under. These accounts include DC OneCard accounts which are automatically created for students who have a DC OneCard credential.

Study Room Use – Number of times a study room is used.

Vacancy Rate – The total number of vacant positions divided by the total number of authorized positions.
